

Online Education

Online classes begin on August 15, 2011 unless otherwise noted. Students will have access to online courses a few days before the class begins from www.napavalley.edu/online-ed. Please refer to SCHEDULE OF CLASSES section for additional information.

Napa Valley College offers many classes that can be completed entirely or in part online. A “hybrid” class is one that has some regular class meetings, with most class work completed online. Online Education offers students the flexibility of taking a class without having to come to campus and without having to attend class on a fixed schedule. Before registering for an online class, consider the following to be sure you are ready:

- You must have reliable access to a computer with Internet access (MAC or PC).
- Be knowledgeable about how to use email, an Internet browser, and a word processing program.
- Have the time management and organizational skills required to complete the course.
- Be comfortable working on your own without face-to-face contact with a teacher or other students.

You can register for all online classes using the college registration process and WebAdvisor. Once registered, be sure to make note of when the class begins. Many online classes start with the regular semester while others begin later into the semester. These “late-start” classes can start as much as six weeks after the regular semester. You will not receive any other communication or instruction from the college after you have registered. It is your responsibility to be prepared and to start the course when it begins. Consult the Online Education web page at www.napavalley.edu/online-ed to confirm the orientation requirements for your course. This web page has important information about how to access “Blackboard,” the online course software.

Your Blackboard ID is the first two letters of your first name and the first two letters of your last name, followed by the last 4 digits of your Student ID number. For example, if your name is James Smith and your student id is 2345678, your Blackboard ID would be JASM5678. For all students, the default password is STUDENT.
